



6th Grade School Supply List



6th graders change classrooms for different subjects, so it is important that all students are able to keep their materials in an organized system for quick and easy access. Students will receive a **planner/assignment book** on the first day of school.

All students should bring the following supplies to the first day of school:

- 1 Binder Package to be purchased from school \$25
(Includes binders, dividers, pencil case) Please see separate handout for ordering.
- For your pencil case:
 - o pencils
 - o pencil sharpener
 - o scissors
 - o an eraser
 - o a glue stick
 - o a highlighter
 - o a blue/black ink pen
 - o a red ink pen
 - o a dryer erase marker
 - o a regular black Sharpie
 - o a thin black Sharpie
 - o 1 pack of colored pencils (at least 8 count)
- 1 Headphones (inexpensive pair in a ziplock bag to keep at school for individual use)
- 1 9x12 Sketch Book (50 sheet or more, drawing, sketch, or mixed media paper)

Please bring the following supplies to contribute to the classroom community:

- 1 – package of baby wipes for hands
- 1 – packages of wide ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper
- 2 – boxes of tissues
- 2 – Lysol or other disinfecting wipes
- 1 Package of 3x3 Post-its (any color)
- For the Art Room: 1 pencil, 1 glue stick, 1 block eraser

All students should have access to the following supplies at home:

- Reference materials: calculator, internet
- A lifetime supply of pencils (to replenish pencil case as needed)
- A lifetime supply of gluesticks (to replenish pencil case as needed)
- Art supplies: crayons, colored pencils, markers
- Loose leaf paper
- Index cards
- French dictionary (Recommended: *Universal Dictionary-French* by Langenscheidt Pub., Inc.; ISBN: 3468981945)
- Latin dictionary (Recommended: Collins-Gem *Latin Dictionary* [mini] by HaperCollins Publishers; ISBN: 000470763X)

All supplies should be replenished throughout the year, as needed.
